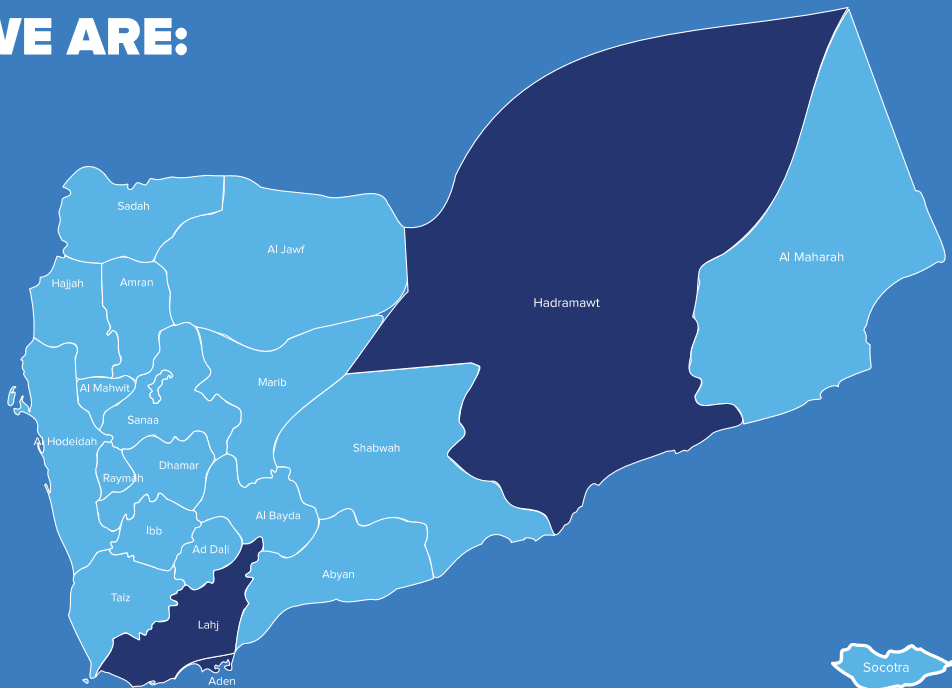

IMPACT SO FAR



12 community initiatives completed.



Peace Supporting
6 safe spaces for three mothers



6 peace committees (20 members in each committee) were established in all targeted districts



120 peace committee members completed their trainings in peacebuilding and conflict resolution at the community levels

Training topics included:



81 Beneficiaries completed vocational training in phone maintenance



216 Beneficiaries completed vocational training in solar



184 Beneficiaries completed vocational training in textiles



149 Beneficiaries completed vocational training in food processing



630 Beneficiaries completed the entrepreneurship and financial literacy training



318 Beneficiaries received in-kind start-up grants
